**PART A: PARTICULARS OF PARTIES**

1. Party 1 is **JANE DOE**, of **123 Queen Street** in **Vancouver**, British Columbia.
2. Party 1 was born on **1 April 1968**.
3. Party 1 has been ordinarily resident in British Columbia since **her birth**.
4. Party 2 is **JOHN DOE**, of **123 King Street** in **Vancouver**, British Columbia.
5. Party 2 was born on **1 May 1969**.
6. Party 2 has been ordinarily resident in British Columbia since **1985**.

**PART B: RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES**

7. The Parties were married on **1 June 1999** at **Vancouver**, British Columbia.
8. The Parties ceased to cohabit on **1 July 2004**.

**PART C: CHILDREN**

- 9.1 There are no children of the marriage as defined by the *Divorce Act* (Canada), nor are the Parties parents as defined by the *Family Relations Act*.

**PART D: DIVORCE**

10. There has been a breakdown in the marriage as defined by the *Divorce Act* (Canada), the particulars of which are as follows:

Pursuant to s. 8(2)(a), the parties have lived separate and apart since 1 July 2004 and will continue to do so for a period of at least one year immediately preceding the determination of the divorce.

11. (a) The surname of Party 1 immediately before marriage was: **Smith**.  
 (b) The surname of Party 1 at birth was: **Smith**.
12. The marital status of Party 1 at the time of marriage was: **never married**.
13. (a) The surname of Party 2 immediately before marriage was: **Doe**.  
 (b) The surname of Party 2 at birth was: **Doe**.
14. The marital status of Party 2 at the time of marriage was: **widowed**.
15. There is no possibility of reconciliation.
16. There has been no collusion in relation to this proceeding. There has been no condonation of any act relied on as a ground for divorce.
17. (a) A certificate of the marriage has been filed.
