**THIS PROCEEDING** coming on before as an undefended divorce proceeding without an oral hearing, and upon reading the affidavits and other documents filed;

**AND UPON THE COURT** being advised that the names and birthdates of the children of the marriage are as follows

Name	Date of Birth
Ogilvy Pritchard Doe	1 June 1999, and
Aemilius Comstock Doe	1 July 2001;

**AND UPON** the Defendant, JOHN DOE, payor, having been found to have a guideline income of \$45,000.00;

**THIS COURT ORDERS** that:

1. subject to Section 12 of the *Divorce Act*, (Canada), the Plaintiff, **JANE DOE**, and the Defendant, **JOHN DOE**, who were married at **Vancouver, British Columbia** on **1 April 1999**, are hereby divorced from each other, the divorce to take effect on the 31st day after the date hereof;

2. The Defendant, **JOHN DOE**, payor, shall pay to the Plaintiff, **JANE DOE**, recipient, the sum of **\$631.00** per month for the support of the children **Ogilvy Pritchard Doe**, born on **1 June 1999**, and **Aemilius Comstock Doe**, born on **1 July 2001**, commencing on the first day of **April 2004** and continuing on the first day of each and every month thereafter so long as the children remain “children of the marriage,” as defined by the *Divorce Act*;

3. The parties shall share the joint permanent custody of the children **Ogilvy Pritchard Doe**, born on **1 June 1999**, and **Aemilius Comstock Doe**, born on **1 July 2001**, and the Plaintiff shall have the children’s primary residence;

4. The parties shall share the joint permanent guardianship of the children **Ogilvy Pritchard Doe**, born on **1 June 1999**, and **Aemilius Comstock Doe**, born on **1 July 2001**, defined as follows

- a) the parents shall be the joint guardians of the estate of the children,
- b) in the event of the death of either parent, the remaining parent shall be the sole guardian of the person of the children,
- c) the Plaintiff shall have the obligation to advise the Defendant of any matters of a significant nature affecting the children,
- d) the Plaintiff shall have the obligation to discuss with the Defendant any significant decisions which have to be made concerning the children, including significant decisions concerning the health (except emergency decisions), education, religious instruction, and general welfare of the children,
- e) the Defendant shall have the obligation to discuss the foregoing issues with the Plaintiff and each parent shall have the obligation to try to reach agreement on those major decisions,

- f) in the event that the parents cannot reach agreement with respect to any major decision despite their best efforts, the Plaintiff shall have the right to make such decision,
- g) the Defendant shall have the right to seek a review of any decision which he considers contrary to the best interests of the children, and
- h) each parent will have the right to obtain information concerning the children directly from third parties, including but not limited to teachers, counsellors, medical professionals, and third party care givers;

and,

5. The Defendant shall have access to the children Ogilvy Pritchard Doe, born on 1 June 1999, and Aemilius Comstock Doe, born on 1 July 2001, on every other weekend, from 4:00pm on Friday to the following Sunday at 7:00pm, and every Wednesday from 4:00pm to 7:00pm, in addition to such other access as the parties may agree,
